

Introduction: Pub Bongsor College

Pub Bongsor College, Pacharia was established in 1994 by the conscious and enthusiastic local social workers of seventeen villages under Pub Bongsor Mouza in the district of Kamrup, Assam. The college is situated on the north bank of the mighty Brahmaputra, and is about fifteen kms away from Gauhati University, and also the nearest Gauhati University affiliated college from the district head quarter i.e. Amingaon. Initially, the classes of the college were started at Dadara H.S. School, and the total administration was shifted to its permanent place in the year 1996. Presently, it has been through the procedure of Post Provincialization as per Assam Venture Educational Institituion (Provincialization of Services) Act, 2011 and Amended, 2012 in respect of Degree Colleges of Assam. Having a good means of transport and communication, the institution of higher education is just three hundred meters away from Guwahati-Singimari-Hajo PWD road and conveniently connected by Pacharia-Singimari PWD Road. The scenic beauty in the midst of agricultural landscape which is free from noise pollution promotes the College for better teaching-learning environment. The College provides the courses in humanities and social sciences.

Admission Procedure

- After the declaration of the Higher Secondary result the admission procedure of B.A. 1st semester is started. Application for admission to the college should be made in the prescribed application form with Prospectus issued by the College Office on the payment of Rs. 100/-.
- b) Candidate will have to appear in the personal interview on the day of admission with two copies of passport size photograph along with their original copies of Mark sheet, Certificates of last qualifying examination and Caste certificate etc.
- c) Separate test is conducted by the Departments in case of major subjects.
- d) Admission is done strictly on the basis of merit of the candidate. The decision of the college authority is final in case of admission.
- e) The limitation of seats in the subjects will be observed by the Admission Cell.

College Uniform

The college authority of Pub Bongsor College has prescribed the following garments as uniform for the students:-

For Boys: Formal black long pant with pink striped formal shirt.

For Girls: White salwar, white churni with pink striped formal kurti.

*Casual and informal garments including jeans are strictly prohibited. Winter wears are observed by the authority.

Identity Card

Each student will be issued College Identity Card after the admission. During college hours the student will have to possess the College Identity Card. In certain occasions of the College, such as Fresher's Ceremony, College Week etc. the students are needed to produce their Identity Cards.



College Library

The College Library has a collection of approximately 2500 of text books, references, journals and other documents covering wide range of subjects. Besides these, two regional daily news papers, seven monthly magazines / periodicals are available in the Library.



Working Hours: from 9.15 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.

To obtain the books from the Library the student must have to produce the Library Card which will be collected from the Librarian of the College.

Attendance Rules

a) The college hour is from 9:15 a.m. to 3:15 p.m.

- b) It is compulsory for all students to have the minimum attendance of 75% of total classes held.
- c) Less than 75% attendance on the part of the student will be counted as noncollegiate. Such student will have to face disciplinary action decided by the College authority.
- d) Students, failed to attend their classes for a week or more on genuine grounds must apply immediately after such absence with supported documents to the Principal for consideration the absence.
- e) The students have to appear the Sessional Examinations conducted by concerned Departments as follows:

2nd/4th/6th Semester: 1st Sessional Examination- within 15th - 30th February

Disciplinary Rules for the students

- a) The students admitted to the College must abide by all rules and regulations as prescribed by the College authority. Violation of rules must lead students to disciplinary actions like termination of scholarship, forced transfer, to make Non-collegiate or Dis-collegiate and even expulsion from the College.
- b) Any form of ragging and mental harassment in the College premises is strictly prohibited.
- c) Damaging, defecting, devaluing or destroying of any College property will lead to penal action as deemed fit and proper by the College authority.



- d) No student is allowed to keep sports goods, musical instrument of the College in his/ her custody without the consent of the proper authority.
- e) Smoking, taking gutkhas, tobacco, alcoholic items and drugs and spitting on walls or in the classroom are strictly prohibited in the College campus. If found such practices strong disciplinary action is the consequence.
- f) Students must attend College in college uniform.
- g) Students must bring the Identity Cards regularly and the same is to be produced when asked for.
- h) Use of mobile phones in the class room and on the verandah is strictly prohibited.
- Making unnecessary hue and cry, blowing of vehicle horn in the College premises is strictly prohibited.
- j) Students are asked to look at the Notice Board soon after they arrive and leave the College to familiarize themselves with the rules and regulations of the College.
- K) The students are asked to convey good co-operation with the faculty and staff regarding such matters which may harm the academic environment of the college.
